 - e) Adoption of Minutes
 - f) Business Arising from minutes
 - g) Unfinished business
 - h) New Business
 - i) Bylaws/Policies
 - j) Accounts for Approval
 - k) Financial Report
 - I) Reports of administration and committees
 - m) Mayor and councillors forum
 - n) Correspondence
 - o) Communications
 - p) Notice of proclamations
 - q) Presentations and recognitions
 - r) Public forum
 - s) Adjournment
- 2) That Section 33.4 be removed and replaced as follows:
 - 33.4 The Mayor may make a motion from the position of the chair.
